#### Arena eventing is back!

- DO NOT jump alone
- If you have a fall, or see something that is unsafe, no matter how minor, please report it online at www.papatoetoeponyclub.co.nz

Setting up of the arena will take place on 15 September. Please take care on site during this time as tractors and moving vehicles will be in and around the arena. Do not jump the fences until advised to do so.
