General safety signage	<ul><li>Injury</li><li>Property damage</li><li>Product damage</li></ul>	М		М	<ul> <li>Display signage H&amp;S at all entrances and identify areas of risk or hazard.</li> <li>Display signage in areas where specific PPE usage is required.</li> </ul>
Emergency safety signage	<ul><li>Injury</li><li>Serious injury</li></ul>	Н		М	<ul> <li>All safety signage needs to be visible.</li> <li>Signage must be large enough to read.</li> <li>Emergency plan to be on display for all to see.</li> </ul>
Slips/Trips/Falls	<ul><li>Injury</li><li>Serious Injury</li></ul>	М		М	<ul> <li>Identify "no go" zones and enforce.</li> <li>Wear safety footwear suitable for the environment.</li> <li>Identify and clear the route of travel making any hazards safe.</li> <li>Three points of contact when climbing up, over or down from equipment, ladders, stairs, etc.</li> <li>Use safe lifting techniques or more than one person to move heavy items.</li> <li>If trained, use lifting / moving equipment (e.g. tractor, gator)</li> <li>Keep work areas/walking paths clear (housekeeping).</li> </ul>
