If trained, use lifting / moving equipment (e.g. tractor, gator) Keep work areas/walking paths clear (housekeeping). Report hazards and risks via the PPC website
Hazardous chemicals	FireIllness	Н		М	 Storage of flammable liquids, gasses and fuel over 25 litres in volume must be in a flame proof cabinet. Gas cylinders stored in a well ventilated area. Kept locked to prevent unauthorised access Safety signage displayed. Be in the fire safety plan.
